


LACROSSE CURSORS/POINTERS

Would you like to show your lacrosse spirit by customizing your PC so that it uses lacrosse cursors in place of the standard arrows and hourglasses? If you would, follow the instructions below and you can turn your boring pointers into cool lacrosse sticks and your hourglasses into animated goalies and defensemen. CURSOR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- I. Click on the goalie  to download the cursor file. Save it to a familiar directory.
- II. Double click on the lcursor.exe file, now located in the directory you selected. The cursor files will be extracted to your C:\windows\cursors file.
- III. Using the Cursors in Windows 95 or 98
 1. Click, "Start," "Settings," Control Panel," "Mouse."
 2. In the "Mouse Properties" dialogue box choose, "Pointers." In the Mouse Properties window you should see all of your PC's cursors, including the lacrosse cursors that you just added. If not, click on the "Browse" button and make sure you're in the "C:\windows\cursors" directory, and if you're not use the navigation tools to go there.
 3. Highlight, "Normal Select" to make your first selection for the mouse pointer by clicking over it, and then choose, "Browse" and select the cursor that you want to use as your primary pointer.
 4. Select the remaining cursors according to the following grouping so that all of your cursors (and tasks) are matched accordingly. (Go through the list one by one until you're done). As an example:
 - a. **Normal Select:** Pick your favorite color lacrosse stick.
 - b. **Help Select:** Another color stick
 - c. **Working in Background:** One of the animated cursors, like the Goalie or Defenseman
 - d. **Busy:** Another animated cursor. Maybe "Iax" or "Vail"
 - e. **Precision Select:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function
 - f. **Text Select:** Another lacrosse stick.
 - g. **Handwriting:** Another stick
 - h. **Unavailable:** One of the animated cursors, like the goalie.
 - i. **Vertical Resize:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function.
 - j. **Horizontal Resize:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function.
 - k. **Diagonal Resize 1:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function
 - l. **Diagonal Resize 2:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function
 - m. **Move:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function
 - n. **Alternate Select:** DON'T CHANGE. The default performs a valuable function
 5. Choose "Save As" and give a name to the pointer group that you just created -- e.g. "Lacrosse". If you want more info, open the readme.txt file that was downloaded with the cursors.
